THE ISGF FELLOWSHIP TOY PROJECT

The first shipment of Toy were distributed to Syrian refugee children in camp Zaatari, Jordan in December 2014. A further shipment was sent and distributed in May 2014. The third shipment was sent to a second camp, Azraq. The forth, and final shipment of 197 boxes was collected and despatched to Jordan in December 2014. By 6th January 2015 they had been loaded onto a truck, with all paperwork complete at Zerga for transport to Azraq, however due to the bad weather it was unable to leave on that date, it has subsequently arrived at Azraq and the toys are awaiting distribution to the children.

We would not have been able to take part in this project without considerable help and therefore at its conclusion we would like to express our thanks to our partner organisations, UNHCR, AWB, Pitt-Rivers Museum, Gist Logistics, and the ISTAT Foundation. Just over 17,000 toys were collected in total. A presentation on this project was made at the World Conference, along with presentations from France and Bangladesh on their projects.
